

CLIMATE ACTION ALERT for all 4RG members

The ISSUE: The Ontario government says it will repeal the legal sections of the 2018 **Cap and Trade Cancellation Act** requiring the province to establish emissions reductions targets, prepare a climate plan and issue progress reports. This bill would prevent groups like the youth one from challenging Ontario government action.

HERE'S WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- Contact your representative(s) and tell them what you want.
- Ask the reader to respond to your email.
- Say that you are a voter and give your address and/or your postal code.

Talking points: (Put these in your own words, and add your own points.)

- Say that you are a voter and give your address.
- Tell Premier Ford this is unacceptable.
- Ontario must have a plan to reduce carbon emissions, including issuing progress reports, to prevent the effects of climate change from becoming much worse.
- Climate change is already affecting Ontario's environment, economy, and health by threatening agriculture, damaging infrastructure, and exposing citizens to extreme heat and forest-fire smoke.
- 2025 was one of the worst forest-fire seasons on record in Ontario, with nearly 600,000 acres burned, made much worse by climate change. Forest-fire smoke is a major health hazard.
