DO's :

- **DO** use the awesome categories feature when you post something. A question should go to "Ask" category. You're smart, you'll figure it out.
- **DO** post amazing things related to Front End, Javascript, HTML5, CSS3, graceful degradation, responsive web design, browsers, etc.
- **DO** engage in discussions regarding web standards, best practices, mobile web, web in general
- **DO** invite your friends, boyfriends, girlfriends , dogs, cats, mice, and others...

DONT's :

- **DON'T SPAM!** - The following things are considered spam and will be deleted
 - Another G+ **community**
 - Non-**English** content
 - Shameless **self** promotion
 - **Unrelated** content
 - Just saying **Hi**
 - **Jobs** / vacancies
- **DON'T** post duplicate links/questions without searching if they were already posted.
- **DON'T** post stuff about the back-end : PHP, Python, Ruby, Java, C#, etc. unless it's regarding views / templating / processing.
- **DON'T** post questions unless you've googled them first!
- **DON'T** use tables for layout - it's EVIL.
- **DON'T** be a troll! Trolling isn't friendly, and it's your real name here on G+, so behave.

TS'OK's :

- **TS'OK** to post an off-topic once in a while (but under the off-topic category only)

- **TS'OK** to idle about and just learn
- **TS'OK** to have fun
