Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Just A Note Stamp Set (166098); With You In Mind Stamp Set (164747); Not 29 Anymore (166182)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Timid Tiger Card Stock (165626); Strawberry Slush Card Stock (165625); Basic White Card Stock (166780); 2025-2027 In Color Designer Series Paper (165300); Textured Metallic Specialty Paper (163772)
- **Stamp Pads:** Early Espresso Ink (147114); Strawberry Slush Ink (165286); Tuxedo Black Memento (132708)
- **Tools:** Just A Note Dies (166101); Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)
- **Miscellaneous:** Strawberry Slush & Pretty In Pink Gems (165615); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813)



Measurements:

- Timid Tiger Card Stock: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", 2" x 2"
- Basic White Card Stock: 4" x 3", 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- Strawberry Slush Card Stock: 3 1/4" x 3/8"
- DSP: 5 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- Metallic Paper: 1" x 1 1/2"

Instructions:

1. Fold the Timid Tiger Card Base in half to create your card.
2. Adhere the DSP (designer series paper) to the left side of the card front.
3. Die cut a small circle from Basic White using the Stylish Shapes Circle die (sized to fit the cupcake from "With You In Mind"). Also, die-cut the note paper shape from Basic White cardstock.
4. Stamp the line stamp onto the note paper die cut using Memento Ink.
5. Die-cut two sets of Timid Tiger arrows.
6. Stamp "Happy Birthday" from the "Not 29 Anymore" set onto the strip of Strawberry Slush cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut the words apart and adhere them to the note paper die cut with Stampin' Dimensionals.

7. Die-cut the paper clip from the Dark Metallic Paper and adhere it to the note paper.
8. Stamp the cupcake onto the circle by inking the cupcake base with Early Espresso and the frosting with Strawberry Slush. Adhere it to the note paper with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Arrange and adhere the Timid Tiger arrows to draw attention to the words and cupcake.
10. Add three Strawberry Slush gems to the card front.
11. Stamp the inside of the card and the envelope to coordinate.
