

****MAGNIFIQUE Act****

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

****Whereas****, When boasting about the size of the economy and American industry, one must be modest and humble, especially if there is a chance of being correct due to a statistical margin of error;

****Whereas****, Underestimating industrial, particularly quarrying, numbers is a great way to keep economic boasting humble and accurate;

****Section 1. Short Title****

(a) This act may be cited as the “MAGNIFIQUE Act”, or the “Make America’s Great Numbers In Fields of Industry and Quarrying Under Estimated.”.

****Section 2. Provisions ****

(a) All industrial economic figures released by the federal government shall be understated by 3%.

(b) Figures released about the quarrying industry shall be understated by a further 5%.

(c) In all applicable circumstances, a notice or footnote must be included to declare that these numbers are understated by the appropriate percentages, so that nobody is misinformed by the released figures.

****Section 3. Enactment****

(a) Immediately after passage of this bill, all sections shall go into effect.

(b) If any part of this bill is halted by the Supreme Court, the rest of the bill will still continue into law.
