## Certificate Courses Compulsory Pre-Placement Requirements (Mandatory Checks)

Mandatory Checks Required for all students  Immunisation and Serology (click on the blue hyperlinks below for further information)	
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	Vaccinations take up to 1 month to complete
<u>Varicella (Chicken Pox)</u>	Vaccinations take up to 1 month to complete
COVID-19 Vaccine	Vaccinations take up to 6 months to complete
Pertussis (Whooping Cough)	Renewed once every 10 years
<u>Influenza</u>	Annual vaccination
Tuberculosis (Risk Assessment)	Delays may apply if additional screening is required

Working With Children	This item may take <b>over 28 business days</b> to complete
Australian Federal Police Check	This item may take <b>over 28 business days</b> to complete

CQUniversity Student ID	Renewed every <b>3 years</b>
Site-required Checks  Dependent on placement facility requirements  Your placement officer will advise if you require these checks for your placement.  To minimise any impact on your placements it is recommended you obtain these checks.	
Hepatitis A	This item may take up to <b>6 months</b> to complete
