

# Exploring Nature

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Exploring Nature (166913); Unbridled Beauty (167219)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Mossy Meadow (133676); Basic Beige (164511); Timid Tiger (165626); Beach Boardwalk Designer Series Paper (DSP) (166820)
- **Stamp Pads:** Secret Sea (165285)
- **Tools:** 1 7/8" Circle Punch (165259); 1 3/4" Circle Punch (119850); Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends (154882); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Lovely Stripes 3D Embossing Folder (167179)
- **Miscellaneous:** Linen Thread (104199); Pressed Flowers Motifs (165215); Stampin' SEAL (152813); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

## Measurements:

- Mossy Meadow: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" card base
- Mossy Meadow: 4" x 5 1/4" layer
- Basic Beige: 3 1/8" x 4 1/8" layer + 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for circle
- Timid Tiger: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for circle
- Beach Boardwalk DSP: 3" x 4"
- Twine: 20" approx.

## Instructions:

1. Score the Mossy Meadow card base on the long side at 4 1/4" and fold.
2. Emboss the Mossy Meadow cardstock layer using the Lovely Stripes 3D Embossing Folder, then adhere it to the card base with Stampin' SEAL.
3. Stamp the sentiment from Exploring Nature on the piece of Beach Boardwalk DSP using Secret Sea ink. Then, attach the DSP onto the Basic Beige layer using Stampin' SEAL.
4. Add the DSP layer to the card front using Stampin' SEAL as shown. It's tilted to the left to accommodate the horse.
5. Punch out a 1 3/4" circle using Basic Beige cardstock and stamp the horse using Secret Sea ink. Then, color using Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends.
6. Add the horse to a 1 7/8" punched circle using Timid Tiger.
7. Pop up the layering circles to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Next, cut off about 20" of Linen Thread and fold it in half. Make a knot with the thread leaving a big loop at the top. Use a glue dot to attach the thread to the card at the knot.
9. Add three Pressed Flower Motifs to the card to finish.
