

1. Bartering items is different from when you buy goods because you weren't spending money, you were trading your items for things that you wanted, needed, or you thought it was cool. It surprised me how hard it was to barer. If you wanted an item someone else had but they didn't want your item, you had to trade with other people until you got a better item to give to that person for the thing you wanted. What I enjoyed most was the fact that it was helping us learn about life in the past but it was a lot of fun. It didn't feel like learning but at the end I was thinking about how life was a long time ago and how complicated it must have been a long time ago to barter for things you needed to survive or make a living.

I was surprised that everyone had some pretty good stuff, because I thought that the stuff wasn't gonna be that good! I enjoyed that I got to keep my item that I traded and I had fun!
