### SSG OATH TAKING CEREMONY

Oath-taking is a planned event by the COMELEC after a successful election, it is one in which the elected officers, the Supreme Student Government in this regard, will take their oath of office and its specific responsibility formalizing their position. This year's election though posed a challenge, as the new normal becomes a burden to the mental healths and overwhelming academic activities, only 3 students applied for office leaving the other 15 positions in vacancy resulted in the CSNHS SSG COMELEC to proceed with the appointments with approval from the panel on appointments and the principal.

Moving on to the Oath Taking Ceremony, the announcement of the scheduled date with the programs attached to the link was sent a day after the formal announcement of the appointees. Oath of Office documents of the officers was also asked to be submitted and a school uniform or white T-shirt was requested to be worn during the event. The g-meet link was sent at 10:40 am, and the facilitators accepted participants at 1:00 pm.

The guest speaker of this event was Hon. Ghriel "Oying" G. Rosales, one of the city councilors of Naga city and has been an active youth leader.

The said event was planned to start at 1:00 pm as per their schedule, yet an unforeseen event, and in this instance was the absence of the school principal that has an important role, causes the event to start late from its scheduled time. The COMELEC, as well as the officers, waited patiently, though some are leaving to reduce data consumption and some are disconnecting. The event started at 1:50 still, without the presence of the principal. The Lupang Hinarang and opening prayer were followed by the opening remarks from the COMELEC Chairman Mr. Miguel Eronga then Mr. Rosales shared an inspirational message to the officers, how leadership is something important, he shared his achievements and life story to inspire. 
