List of cleaning tasks:

Does not have to be done in list order

Reminder no sweeping the under any circumstance - mopping or wet sponge only

Downstairs:

- 1. **EVERY SHIFT:** Take the trash out (downstairs 2 cans, bathroom, upstairs can) Extra trash bags are in the bathroom
- EVERY SHIFT: Clean bathroom sink and toilet cleaning supplies in the bathroom.
 - a. Extra toilet paper/paper towels is either in the bathroom or upstairs if you ever can't find it and it's empty shoot Rosalie an email
 - b. Keys to unlock toilet paper/paper towel dispensers are behind bathroom mirror (it slides open)
- 3. EVERY WEEK: Empty the slop / clay bucket and clean it
 - a. Bring the bucket out the main door * (by the construction) and walk in between the Coop building and the shed to the corner by the fence (this is the <u>clay graveyard</u>). Get as much clay out as possible, which might require:
 - i. Scraping clay out with a large rib / tool (like one of the brushes near the sink)
 - ii. Rinsing with water buckets from inside
 - b. Clean the <u>INSIDE AND OUTSIDE</u> of the bucket before putting it back in the sink with clean water filling it
 - c. * If its too heavy to safely carry, take some small buckets of the surface water out to the same area and dump them there
- 4. Wipe down the exterior of all slop/clay buckets
- 5. Clean walls around slop/clay buckets
- 6. Scrub down wedging table/red clay wedging board
- 7. Wipe down sink
- 8. Clean main table clean out tools in cups, put tools in correct places
- 9. Clean tools + center wall/pillar
- 10. Clean wall around clay mixer
- 11. Wipe down all wheels
- 12. Clean all bats

Upstairs

- EVERY SHIFT: Wash floor bucket and sponge (or mop that is in the corner behind upstairs sink)
- EVERY SHIFT: Washing steps leading upstairs bucket and sponge
- Wash table by sink and main table
- Organize table next to sink and shelves next to sink

- Clean railing behind sink/table
- Sponge down glaze buckets, make sure names are visible re-tape/label buckets if necessary
- Clean & straighten rear counter by window (glaze prep table)
- Carefully sweep up glaze shards by grinder (*danger* sharp edges!)
