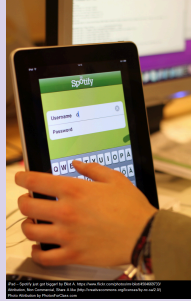


iPad Apps and Websites with Shareable URLs for Student Projects

This is a “list in progress” of apps and websites that students may use in the classroom which give a shareable URL. Why is this important to have a shareable URL? Just as a student would turn in a paper assignment for a grade, students need to be graded on projects and items completed on an iPad. I have seen many teachers take home all student iPads on the weekends to get caught up on their grading. Now that many students have gone 1:1 and digital, it is time that teachers go digital as well. As students complete projects, there are some apps that allow students to share a URL link to their project. This is very helpful as these URL links can be turned into the teacher for teacher review.

URL links may be shared many ways between the student and teacher. Here are a list of ways that sharing can happen:

- Email - Student's can email the link to their teacher. This is simple, but may result in an overwhelming amount of emails. *Students must have an email account as well.
- Text messages - This works, but who wants to give out their personal cell phone number to students?
- Using a Learning Management System (LMS) such as Blackboard, Moodle, Edmodo, Google Classroom, etc. This is a simple way, but a LMS needs to be in place in a teachers classroom already.
- Google Form - MY PERSONAL FAVORITE - Create a Google Form which will act like an [assignment dropbox](#) (example) or [assignment dropbox 2](#) (example). Students enter their name, class, and the URL of their project. These dropboxes can be customized to each teachers needs. Teachers will then have a [spreadsheet](#) of student assignment URLs!



Once you have a system that allows students to share their projects with you, you need to know about which apps can share with a URL link. There are a ton of awesome apps out there, but only a select few so far that give this URL out. Many apps allow you to share through Facebook, YouTube, and email, but these options are usually out of the question in a school setting. So here is my “list in progress”. All of these are iPad apps, which many are also available on other tablets and on the web.
