## Park Hill School District Resource List

**Free & Reduced Meals**: Meals are free for all children, ages 18 and under, through the end of the 2021-2022 school year. Children can receive up to one breakfast and one lunch each day. You may still fill out the F & R form which may help qualify your student for other services. This form needs to be turned into the school office and is then sent to the Park Hill Food Service.

**Food: Back Snack:** This service provides supplemental meals for kids over the weekend. Food items will be sent home in your child's backpack.

**Missouri HealthNet Insurance for Kids**: To complete your application online please visit: <a href="https://mydss.mo.gov/">https://mydss.mo.gov/</a>. If you have questions or need assistance completing the application, call Missouri Medicaid at 1-855-373-4636. You can also contact me for help.

Park Hill PTA Clothing Center: This service is provided through the Park Hill School District PTA. As such, they will need proof your child attends a Park Hill school to receive this service. This could be a class schedule, student ID or the provided enclosed letter. A schedule of when this service is provided can be found on the Park Hill website under: Parent Resources – PTA – Clothing Center. I can also send a copy of this schedule home with your child or via email.

**School Supplies**: If you need assistance meeting school supplies need throughout the year, please contact your child's teacher and/or me. When school supply fairs and events occur, this information will be shared with you by way of emails and/or via the Parent Newsletter.

**Dental (Level Up - Miles of Smiles)** This free dental service is provided each year within your child's school. Please fully complete the application (including signing all 3 places on the application) to see if your child is eligible for this service. You may also complete this application online at <a href="http://levelupkidsinc.org/patientinfo">http://levelupkidsinc.org/patientinfo</a>. This program begins August 26<sup>th</sup>. Please complete your form and return to TR as early as possible.

**Vision (Level Up – I Care for Kids)** This free vision service is provided within your child's school. Please complete the application (including signing all 3 places on the application) to see if your child is eligible for this program. You may also complete this application online at <a href="http://levelupkidsinc.org/patientinfo">http://levelupkidsinc.org/patientinfo</a>.

**ReFresh Hygiene Pantry:** This is a free pantry where hygiene items such as shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shaving crème, lotions, etc can be received when a referral from the school social worker is made.

**General Community Resources**: I am happy to send you a list of general community resources via email or home with your child. You may also call 211 for resource assistance as they are available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.
