Unit 1 Lesson 12



Aim: Students will learn to identify and match common school supplies with their silhouettes, enhancing their recognition and fine motor skills.

Time: 45-60 minutes

Materials:

- Real school supplies (book, crayon, scissors, backpack, pencil case)
- Crayons or markers
- Flashcards or cut-outs with pictures of school supplies

Tip: For better control in class, one way to do the activities suggested in this lesson is having students take turns.

Engage:

Show and Tell

Begin the lesson by showing the real school supplies to the students. Ask the students to name each item as you show it. For example, "What is this?" (Hold up the book).

Explore & Practice:

Matching Game

Tell students they will match each school supply to its corresponding silhouette. Display the book and demonstrate an example of matching one item to its silhouette with a line.

With the Book

Students work individually or in pairs to draw lines from each school supply to its silhouette. Walk around the classroom to assist students who may need help.

Flash card game

Place real school supplies on the desks. Hide flashcards around the classroom. Tell students they will find the flashcards and match them with the real items on their desks. Allow students to search for the flashcards. Once found, students return to their desks and match the flashcards to the real school supplies.

Closing:

Review and Share

Gather students in a circle and review the matched items. Ask students to hold up their matched pairs and say the name of the school supply.

Allow students to share which activity they enjoyed the most and why.

Praise the students for their effort and participation.
