Guide for Experts

All manuscripts submitted to the Journal for publication are reviewed. The review should provide a comprehensive and objective assessment and analysis of the advantages and disadvantages of the presented manuscript. Both members of the journal's Editorial Board and external Reviewers holding, as a rule, PhD or Dr.Sci. degree and experience in scientific research in the field relevant to the manuscript are involved in this process.

At least two experts will evaluate the manuscript. The length of the review is not regulated, but, as a rule, it should not be longer 1-2 sheets of typewritten text. The review should not exceed 2 weeks from the date of receipt of the manuscript by the Reviewer. All reviews are kept in the Editorial Office for 5 years. The peer reviewing of manuscripts in «Reviews on Advanced Materials and Technologies» is not paid.

The Editorial Office does not provide information about the Reviewer to the Authors of manuscripts.

The review can be written in free form or according to the <u>enclosed form</u>, but it is obligatory that it contains the following aspects:

All remarks for convenience of consideration by the Editors and the Author (Authors) should be grouped into points.

The review should be concluded with one of the following recommendations:
