

Ski & Snowboard Club Information, Rules and Regulations

DEPARTURE TIMES: The buses will leave from Centennial Middle School (CMS) promptly at 2 p.m. Buses will begin loading at 1:45 p.m. **All students participating in this program MUST ride the bus to and from the ski area unless arrangements have been made in advance with Community Education. (The one exception is in case of injury.) Only those registered in the ski club can ride the bus.**

RETURN TIME: The buses will arrive back at CMS at approximately **9 p.m.** Please make sure you are here to pick up your student(s) at this time. Late pick up may result in your student being removed from the ski/snowboard club with **no refund.**

BAD WEATHER: It may become necessary to cancel a trip due to bad weather. Announcements will be made Friday at the school if possible. If it becomes necessary to cancel a trip on Saturday, an email notification will be sent prior to noon. You can also call and listen to Cori Sendle's voicemail at (763) 792-6101 for cancellation information. If necessary, we have a make-up date on Feb 28.

INJURY PROCEDURES: PARENTS PLEASE INFORM YOUR SON OR DAUGHTER OF YOUR WHEREABOUTS DURING THE TIME WE WILL BE SKIING/SNOWBOARDING. Injured skiers/snowboarders will be taken to the First Aid Room. The ski area has the right to call an ambulance if they decide it is necessary. The advisor is informed, and he/she will inform the student's parents. There are two ways an injured skier/snowboarder will return after an injury:

- 1. The student waits and takes the bus back.
- 2. The parents drive to the ski area or the hospital and they drive the student home.
 - *Please bring dry clothes when picking up an injured skier/snowboarder.

BUS CONDUCT: SKIERS/SNOWBOARDERS WILL FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE BUS DRIVER AND THE CHAPERONES.

- You must always remain seated and no changing of seats when the bus is in motion.
- No standing while the bus is moving or kneeling facing backwards.
- The use of profane language will not be tolerated.
- No throwing of objects. If the bus is a mess, the students will stay and clean up before they go home.
- No eating while on the bus. All food must stay in their bags.
- There will be two people in a seat; no lying down.
- You must face the front, no feet over the backs of the seats.
- The first and last seats on the passenger side are reserved for the chaperones. Students should not sit in either of these seats or put their possessions on them.
- Any media/music must be listened to with headphones.

IMPROPER BEHAVIOR: BEHAVIOR OF ALL STUDENTS IN THE SKI & SNOWBOARD CLUB WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE ESTABLISHED CODE OF CONDUCT, RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CENTENNIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (refer to school handbook online). ANY VIOLATION OF THESE RULES OR REGULATIONS COULD RESULT IN SKI & SNOWBOARD CLUB PRIVILEGES BEING TAKEN AWAY OR SUSPENSION WITH NO REFUND! Students are not allowed to have in their possession (at any time) or use (at any time) controlled substances. These include cigarettes, vaping instruments/accessories, chewing tobacco, alcohol, or anything else covered in the school handbook. Students are not allowed in the NON-SKI area. Any infraction of these rules will result in the confiscation of the student's lift ticket and the parents will be notified.
