## Lent

- What is it? (purpose)
  - To prepare us for Easter, Jesus' resurrection
  - To repent and try to be better Catholics
- Liturgical color What does this color mean?
  - Purple penance and preparation
- How long is it?
  - When does it begin? Ash Wednesday
  - When does it end? At the beginning of the Triduum (Holy Thursday night) <u>but</u> Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday are included the count of 40 days because they are still days of penance.
  - Explain the number of days:
    - 46 days if you include Sundays.
    - 40 days doesn't include Sundays because Sunday is always a day of celebration when we remember the Lord's resurrection, even during a penitential season.
- What is different in Mass during Lent?
  - No Gloria
  - No Alleluias! We sing different Gospel Acclamations before the Gospel is read during Lent, such as "Praise to you Lord, Jesus Christ, King of Endless Glory."
  - Very simple/minimal altar decorations, purple
