Use ClassDojo to Create and Share a Classroom Video with Families

Using ClassDojo, you can easily record and share videos of classroom routines or strategies with families. For example, you can take a video of skills you are teaching so that families can do those strategies at home.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS:

- 1.If you take a video that includes students, be sure to get permission from all parents to share videos on ClassDojo. Do not share videos of any students whose parents have not provided media consent. Check with your school administration on their policies for sharing videos with parents on ClassDojo.
- 2. If you invite parents to join your ClassDojo account, they will get an email or text message. Let them know they can use the BASIC account and do not have to pay for a premium account

What kinds of Family Engagement Videos Can I Make?

- 1. Are you teaching your students a song or activity together? Have your co-teacher or educational assistant take a video as you teach a routine. Post a video of the routine to encourage parents to do the same at home.
- 2. If you are teaching new vocabulary words, take a video as you say and point at the words. Print images of the words and point to those. Parents can watch and do the same at home. Encourage parents of MLLs to do the same activity at home and translate the words into their home language.
- 3. Create a classroom scavenger hunt where students look for objects in the classroom and at home (when they watch the video with their parents). They can look for objects of a certain shape, color, or number.)
- 4. Share with parents what you have done in class that they can extend at home (e.g., planting seeds, caring for animals).
