

Uploading or Changing Your Profile Photo on ChurchofJesusChrist.org

Before You Upload a Photo

Please review the following guidelines before submitting your photo:

- You must have the legal right to use the photo. Do not upload professional studio photos unless you have permission from the photographer.
- The photo must not display trademarks, logos, or copyrighted material belonging to others. It should not promote businesses, products, or services.
- Everyone shown in the photo must consent to its posting. If anyone in the photo is a minor, a parent or legal guardian must grant permission.
- The photo must comply with Church standards. It should not express political opinions or promote causes, and it should reflect modesty and dignity.
- The photo should accurately represent you. Do not use altered images, caricatures, impersonations, or heavily filtered photos.

How to Upload or Change Your Photo

Sign in at churchofjesuschrist.org using your Church Account.

Open “My Home” and navigate to the Ward Directory (usually found under the Tools menu or “My Account and Ward”).

Locate your household listing and select your name.

Click the Edit option near your photo:

- Choose “Add Photo” if you do not have one.
- Choose “Change Photo” to replace your current picture.
- Select a photo from your device and follow any prompts to crop or adjust it.
- Click Save or Upload to submit your photo.

Photo Approval

Photos are typically reviewed by a ward leader or clerk before they become visible to others. If your photo does not appear immediately, it may still be pending approval.
