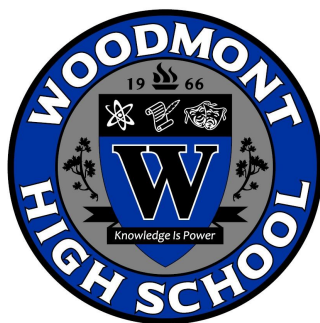

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Course Description:

Artificial Intelligence involves simulating intelligent behavior in computers, encompassing programming, data science, mathematical reasoning, creative problem- solving, ethics, and practical experiences.
