


# **BIST Year 4E Weekly Update**


## Literacy

 During our literacy lessons this week we worked on using context clues in a story to figure out challenging, unknown words, the difference between fact and opinion, text dependent questions, inference, and examining the rise and fall of an adventure story.

• This week in our IPC unit, *Active Planet*, the students continued to learn that rocks undergo changes of form in a rock cycle by completing an accurate and detailed diagram of their own rock cycle. They also completed a rock sort using pictures they had drawn of the different kinds of rocks, grouping different kinds of rocks together on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties and analyzing the criteria they used for the sort. ### **Mathematics**

- Week 16 focuses on ensuring a robust understanding of that place value in decimal numbers:
  - o recognise, use, compare and order decimal numbers
  - o understand place value in decimal numbers; recognise that decimals are tenths
  - round decimals numbers to the nearest whole number
  - divide 2-digit numbers by 10 to get decimal numbers
  - multiply decimal numbers by 10 to get 2-digit numbers
  - o divide 3-digit multiples of ten by 100 to get decimal numbers
  - o multiply decimal numbers by 100 to get 3-digit multiples of ten
  - o add four digit numbers using written method with answers greater than 10 000
