



For daily guests the minimum rate is \$25 (less than two hours) or \$35 (daily parking). Valet is the only way the hotel gives access to their garage. You will see the sign for valet parking when you pull into the front of the hotel.

IMPORTANT LUGGAGE INFORMATION

Check in to individual hotel rooms at Yours Truly will take place at the front desk and will occur after the conference has begun, just before the dinner hour on Sat. Oct. 18. Until then, conference participants staying at the hotel will have a place to keep their luggage.

Check out of the Yours Truly Hotel is at 12:00 p.m. HOWEVER, all conference participants will be leaving the hotel together at 8:00 a.m. on Mon. Oct. 20 for Capitol Hill visits and checking out of your rooms at the hotel needs to happen <u>prior</u> to our 8:00 a.m. departure. The estimated time to check-out is 2-5 minutes. The front desk will have the bellman assist with luggage storage if desired.


Here are a few options to consider for your/your group's luggage on Mon. Oct. 20 morning.

1) Check your luggage with the Yours Truly Hotel. You may return to the hotel to retrieve it after lunch and the closing ceremony at Saint Peter Catholic Church (313 2nd St SE, Washington D.C. 20003), expected to end by 1:00 p.m.

Approximate time to get to Yours Truly Hotel from St. Peter's using the metro: 30 minutes.

Directions: Walk from St. Peter's to **Capitol South Station**, where you can take either the Blue, Orange, or Silver line to **Foggy Botton-GWU station**, where you will depart the metro train and walk to the hotel. Make sure you get on the line going in the direction that will take you to Foggy Botton-GWU.






- 2) Within your group, you may choose to coordinate a driver/van to store your luggage and independently transport it to Capitol Hill, look for parking near Saint Peter Catholic Church (*only* paid street parking available), allowing you to depart from the church at 1:00 p.m, as an alternative to everyone returning to the hotel to retrieve luggage.
- 3) You may also choose to keep your luggage with you for the duration of Monday morning's Hill visits. Please note that while this is possible, it isn't recommended, as it would mean carrying suitcases while walking, on the Metro, and inside the Capitol itself. Security at House and Senate office buildings can also be strict, so having large bags may slow you down or cause extra hassle at checkpoints.

Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA) *closest airport BY CAR:

Approximately 13 minutes, 5 miles.

- Drive from George Washington Mem Pkwy, Arlington Mem Brg and 23rd St NW to Washington
- 2. Head southeast on VA-233 E
- 3. Turn right toward Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport Access Rd/Smith Blvd
- 4. Continue onto Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport Access Rd/Smith Blvd
- Turn right onto the ramp to GW Parkway North/Washington/I-395
- 6. Merge onto George Washington Mem Pkwy
- 7. Use the left lane to take the exit toward US-50 W/Memorial Brg/Arlington Cemetery
- 8. Use the left lane to take the ramp to Memorial Cir
- 9. Use the left lane to continue on Memorial Cir
- 10. Continue onto Arlington Mem Brg/Memorial Brg
- 11. Use the left 2 lanes to turn slightly left toward Lincoln Memorial Cir NW
- 12. Continue onto Lincoln Memorial Cir NW
- 13. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto 23rd St NW
- 14. At Washington Cir NW, take the 3rd exit onto New Hampshire Ave NW
- 15. Destination will be on the left







- 3. Board the Amtrak toward Washington (*pre-booked).
- 4. Ride for 23 minutes to Union Station.
- 5. Transfer to the metro,.
