

# Resolution

(to be part of the Republican Platform under the heading

“Life-Affirming Health Care Concepts”, #145 Preserving the Dignity of Human Embryos”)

WHEREAS, Texas law generally treats frozen embryos as property and not legal persons and therefore that classification drives how courts and clinics approach custody and disposition, and

WHEREAS, Texas does not have an explicit statement in statute that embryos are persons under state law, and Texas has not enacted a clear-cut personhood law for embryos in cases between parents and clinics,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

Add a second sentence to say: “Biological parents or adoptive parents of siblings of any frozen embryos with the biological parents consent where possible, should have primary legal say over a frozen embryo's status and use.”
