

RIT Novice Tournament Information

Teams should arrive in Eastman 3355 between 8:30 AM and 8:45 AM so we can get this tournament started on time. There are 5 teams, so we will unfortunately have to use a schedule with byes. Teams on bye can come to Eastman 3355 to scrimmage on the questions for that round if they wish. The schedule is below:

We will be playing under standard NAQT rules for an untimed match, with one exception - players will have 5 seconds to buzz at the end of a tossup, and 5 seconds to begin their answer after buzzing. Games will be 20 tossups/bonuses.
