While sometimes he has trouble paying attention and absorbing large amounts of information, if an adult helps him, this is lessened. He has low levels of independence and ability to deal with certain situations. He needs help from an adult when dealing with those situations. Georgi can tell what time it is and can use a calendar. He is good at analyzing, summarizing and determining cause-effect relationships. He participates in fast and competitive games and tries hard to win. When he is playing something interesting he gets carried away and may violate some rules. When he does violate them he feels guilty. He is communicative. Georgi has established good friendship relationships with his peers and likes to play with other children. He reportedly has a close relationship with his sister.

Vesselina has good body coordination. She is thin and agile, she likes fast and dynamic games. Her handwriting is beautiful. She can communicate easily with children and adults and talk about her past experiences. Vesselina is a calm child with an open personality, though when meeting new people, she doesn't initiate contact. Socially, she is accepted, valued, and respected. She finished 8th grade in school and does her homework independently. She does chores daily and keeps her room tidy. She likes to make sure her outfits match. Reportedly, she has a close relationship with her brother--protecting him and giving him advice.
