Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Endless Love (167055)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Thick Basic White (159229) Basic Black (121045), Petal Pink (146985), Gold Foil (132622) Made with Love DSP (167054)
- **Stamp Pads:** Cherry Cobbler (147083), Craft White (147277)
- **Tools:** Endless Love dies (167061)
- **Miscellaneous:** Real Red Baker's Twine (164051), Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813)

Measurements:

- Basic White: 4 ¼" x 5 ½", 4 ½" x 6"
- Basic Black: ¾" x 2 ½"
- Petal Pink: ½" x 2 ¼"
- Gold Foil: 2" x 3"
- Designer paper: 2 5/8" x 4 1/8", 4" x 4"
- Red/White Baker's Twine: 10"

Instructions:

1. Cut a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base.
2. Score along the long edge at 2 ¾". Fold in half.
3. Cut a 2 5/8" x 4 1/8" piece of striped designer paper and adhere to the card front.
4. Cut a large Basic White heart.
5. Cut a large heart from the heart designer paper.
6. Adhere the (2) hearts together.
7. Adhere the heart to the card front – making sure the height does not exceed 5 ½. (to fit in the envelope)
8. Stamp the LOVE onto Basic White cardstock using Cherry Cobbler ink.
9. Cut the letters apart and adhere to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Stamp the Valentine sentiment onto Basic Black cardstock using Craft White ink. Let dry completely. Trim to size.
11. Adhere the sentiment to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Stamp the Sending You sentiment onto Petal Pink cardstock using Cherry Cobbler ink. Cut to size.
13. Adhere the sentiment to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Cut a large arrow and (5) little hearts from Gold Foil paper.
15. Tuck and adhere the arrow behind the sentiment.
16. Add the little hearts randomly over the card front as desired.
17. Tie a small bow in the Red/White Baker's twine and adhere to the sentiment using a glue dot.
