WELSH CLASSIC 125 CLASS ELIGIBILITY FOR 2022

For 2022 125cc machines will again race in their own class. Depending on the actual entries on the day (we have 60+ riders as of 22/10/19) the class will be split into A and B ability levels. Details of which bikes are eligible are below.

An additional "D Group" has been approved for 2020 for British machines up to 200cc, details to follow.

Outline

125cc machines *originally equipped* with air cooled engines, drum brakes and non-linkage suspension. This means you can't take a later machine and backdate with it drum brakes, twin shocks etc. Aircooled//Twin shock is not a FORMULA for the class. Machines are encouraged to be as original as possible. Period aftermarket parts (heads, forks, swingarms, etc) are allowed, although water cooled kits are NOT legal. Later parts like flat slide carbs, disc brakes & USD forks are not allowed. Use of the original style tank and seat for the bike's year is recommended to help keep everything looking period. Please ask if not sure.

Period style riding gear whenever possible is also encouraged, even if it is just a retro jersey, it all helps recreate that 1970's Schoolboy feel.

The latest model from each of the following manufacturers is eligible. If you have a bike not listed let us know. Any hybrids, also contact us with photos to assess. Certain other enduro/trail machines may also be allowed.
