

6. Data Analysis and Action to Support High Achievement of All Students – The school uses educationally sound assessment processes to collect data. The school disaggregates and analyzes student performance data and uses the analysis as a basis for instructional/curricular improvement. (Key Self-Study Outcome #4; ACS WASC Category-Based Criteria A.6, B.3; *ISL* Chapter 3-D)

The collection of student achievement data is ongoing (systemic), research based, and includes a variety of assessments* in all grades. There is a high degree of documentation, disaggregation, and discussion of data. Extensive analysis of data includes identifying trends, discerning individual student needs, and using these findings to adjust instruction and enhance programs to improve student learning. (*assessments and disaggregation—see Key Terminology)

There are clear and consistent processes (i.e., PLCs or data teams) for analyzing all sources of data (e.g., observations, student work, computer adaptive technology, and other forms of formative and summative assessments). There is a coordinated effort among faculty, administration, and parents/guardians (when appropriate) to analyze data and supporting documentation is available for review to ensure efficacy of the processes.
