EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025: SAFE SCHOOLS / VECTOR SOLUTIONS COURSES WILL NOT COUNT TOWARDS G/T CREDIT.

Guidelines/Expectations

All teachers of gifted/talented (G/T) are required by the TEA (Texas Education Agency) to have 30 hours of initial G/T training prior to instruction. Courses required are specific to gifted education. Once a teacher has completed the 30 hours, each year they have GT students in their classroom, a 6 hour course called a GT Update is required. This applies to all core content classroom teachers grades k-12 with G/T students on their roster. (TAC Title 19 RULE §89.2)

Frequently Asked Questions

Who needs GT training?

-Full training =

- All secondary Advanced Academic Course, AP, DC, IB teachers and all elementary classroom teachers with GT students in their classroom
 (Math/Science/ELA/SS). All Kinder teachers and all middle school ISC teachers.
- Kinder teacher. Why? You don't have GT identified students until February. It is best practice to have these hours in place before you have GT students.

 Getting the hours in the spring is difficult.
 - 6 Hour GT Update courses are needed each year a teacher is assigned to GT students once the teacher's 30 hours are completed.

-Administrators and counselors need a one-time 6 hour GT course. (NNPO)

What is GT Training?

- -The State of Texas required 30 hours of basic awareness training for teachers of gifted children before the start of the school year. (some exceptions apply for late hires)
 - -The state breaks down training into 3 main topics and SISD breaks that down into FIVE 6 hour courses.(see green box above)
 - -Every year after you have your initial 30 hours, each year a teacher has GT students they are required to complete a 6 hour GT update course.
 - -The order in which you take the courses does not matter.

What do I do with my GT Certificates once I have them completed?

If courses are listed in Eduphoria and you are able to register, don't upload a certificate. (Houston COOP Courses)

If you took a course that was not listed in Eduphoria Strive, (Responsive Learning, APSI, Lonestar, Region 4, HMNS, etc.) you will need to upload

-All certificates from GT training outside SISD need to be uploaded into Eduphoria Strive in order to verify compliance with the TEA requirements stated above. Please follow these detailed instructions, <u>Uploading course requests to Eduphoria</u>. If you have questions or need assistance with the process, please reach out to the SISD Advanced Academics team. ** Note credit approval is not immediate. All certificates will be approved at the district then campus level. Please allow 7-10 days processing time before contacting for outstanding approvals.

If I missed a GT update, do I have to re-take my 30 hours?

-No. You only need an update the years you have GT students. You don't need to re-take your 30 hours.

-you should ALWAYS keep your GT records. If you change districts you may need to re-take your 30 hours if you can't prove you have taken them previously. Your PD records are your responsibility.

When is GT Training?

There are many options for training..

-The initial 30 hours are offered as an institute in SISD in the summer and that is what we highly recommend. If that doesn't work, the courses are also offered through the Houston COOP which is a group of 35 districts that combine to bring in presenters to present to large groups of teachers from across the Houston area. For COOP courses, you register in Eduphoria and a link to the course will be listed in the description. During the School year, COOP courses are on Saturdays or asynchronous.

-There are many options for GT updates. There are courses at the Museum of Natural Science and Offshore Energy. Find something that interests you. Please don't keep repeating the initial 30 hours over and over again.
