Course Description

8th grade science is rooted in inquiry, exploration and collaboration. Through these processes, students will learn the essentials of science and ways to make sense of the world around them. There will be an emphasis on developing the skills of critical thinking, analysis, modeling, and working cooperatively.

Students will be working in their Science Binder most class meetings. This will stay in the classroom, **though it can be brought home for studying**. Quizzes are open note, so it is important to bring the binder back to school, that is the student's responsibility.

Expectations/Agreements

For each type of activity, there are specific expectations of students. These are communicated and posted for everyone to see. Students will follow the class agreements posted in the classroom. Students are also expected to follow the schoolwide rules in the LPSSA 2025-2026 Student-Parent Handbook.

Resources

LPSSA follows the California Integrated Learning Model of the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). We use the Amplify Curriculum, supplemented with materials from Generation Genius and STEMscopes. Activities include plenty of group work and collaboration, as well as independent work.

Course Policies

Homework and Late Work:

Homework will be given seldomly. Most of what needs to be covered can happen during class time. Students can bring in late work until the end of the grading period (for progress and report cards). Review the 25-26 Reporting Schedule on the Middle School Google Classroom for dates. Please notify me when late work is completed.

Make-Up Work

Students who have missed classwork will be expected to do make-ups. **Students are responsible for gathering their work from the "Absent" bin** upon return to school. Digital materials will be on Google Classroom or email (CHECK YOUR EMAIL!). Lab materials will be kept available for a week after a lab is missed, and the lab should be made up during an agreed-upon time. Please notify me when make-up work is completed.

Grading

We use traditional grading in science, and some classwork will be assessed as well as unit quizzes.. All assignments, projects, and quizzes are weighted the same. Students are assessed based on their understanding of the concepts covered with either full, partial, or no credit.

Citizenship Grades

- Outstanding (O) - Student is consistently meeting the expectations of a successful learner in class.
- Satisfactory (S) - Student is generally meeting the expectations of a successful learner in class.
- Needs Improvement (N) - Student is consistently not meeting multiple expectations of a successful learner and/or behavior is disruptive or unsafe to the learning environment. Issues have been documented & communicated to parents.
