BILL C-X

An act to amend the Canada Post Corporation Act

Preamble

Whereas, lettermail in Canada is decreasing;

Whereas, lettermail in Canada is increasing in cost year-over-year;

Whereas, Canada Post should be modernized to become a successful crown corporation; and

Whereas, Canadians may get better lettermail service from a private entity;

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

Short Title

Short title

1 This Act may be known as the Lettermail Fairness Act.

Section 1: Repeal

2 Section 14 and 15 of the Canada Post Corporation Act are repealed in their entirety.

Coming into Force

3 This act will come into force upon receiving Royal Assent.
