Database names	1	Name each individual database searched.	
Citation searching	2	Describe any methods used for locating cited/citing references (e.g., browsing reference lists).	
Other approaches	3	Indicate whether additional studies or data were sought using other approaches (e.g., contacting authors and/or experts).	
How did you search?			
Main concepts and search terms	5	Identify the main concepts that make up your topic and describe how you developed search terms for each main concept.	
Search tactics	6	Indicate what search tactics you used to improve results.	
Limits	7	Describe any limits or restrictions applied to a search (e.g., peer-reviewed, date, language).	
Prior work	8	Indicate when search strategies from other literature reviews were adapted or reused for a substantive part or all of the search, citing the previous review(s).
