## Total Phase 3: 68,700 kr. (last updated 30-11-2018)

Phase 3A (signup) - estimated 25,200 kr.

- 1. **Sign me up (for users):** a new member of KBHFF can sign up online using the website and pay the kontingent.
- 2. Create new member (for shop personnel): the shop staff can sign up members of KBHFF.
- 3. Set up user groups (roles) in Janitor [the new back-end system]: different users have different roles/permissions (e.g. shop personnel, buyer, local administrator) in the Janitor system.
- 4. **Prepare to transfer order data:** script to make sure that we can transfer active orders to the new system when we launch.

Phase 3B (members' help page - Medlemshjælp) - estimated 7,250 kr.

- 1. Launch page with search bar: the shop staff can search for a member, using their name, contact details or member number. This is the first point of access to order something for a member or help edit their profile or orders.
- **2. GDPR consent after launch page:** the shop staff can collect consent from members visiting the shop before they order a bag through the new system.
- Copy of "Min side" for shop staff: allows shop staff to edit members' info (name, type of membership, etc.) and, at a later phase, orders (move an order to another date).

Phase 3C (basic webshop) - estimated 15,375 kr.

- Back-end/database: create product and pick-up date: we can create a new good (e.g. a bag type or an individual good such as onions, potatoes) and set a new pick-up date for members to pick up their goods.
- **2. Basic webshop (for members):** members can order products for a specific date or dates. Existing orders are shown on the webshop page.
- **3. Basic webshop (for shop staff):** shop staff can order a bag of vegetables on behalf of a member.
- **4. Payment in webshop:** orders can be paid with VISA/Mastercard for online orders (not just Dankort), or MobilePay or cash for orders in the shop.

Phase 3D (Required shop customisations) - estimated 13,625 kr.

- **1. Shopping lists:** based on the orders placed, the shop generates a shopping/order list for the buying group.
- 2. **Delivery lists:** the shop generates lists of which orders need to go to which departments. It also produces a list of which members ordered what in each department and the functionality to mark a product as "delivered" to a member.
- **3.** Choose delivery location: a member can choose to which department their order should be delivered. (may be pushed to a later phase)
- **4. Edit orders:** a member can edit their order after placing it, by moving it to a future date.

## Phase 3E (Mass email) - estimated 7,250 kr.

- 1. All members list: we can send an email to all KBHFF members (no opt-out option service emails only).
- 2. **Departments list:** a department can use the website to send an email to all its members (no opt-out option service emails only).
- 3. **Newsletter:** we can send out a regular newsletter, using a template. Members can subscribe to / unsubscribe from the newsletter on their "Min side" and from a link in the newsletter itself.

After the completion of phase 3, we will be able to launch and run the new system.

## Extra features (later phases) - estimated 70,000 kr.

We estimate these features would need approximately 70,000 kr. and 3 months of work (based on what we currently know of the new system and the features' descriptions).

- **1. Subscriptions:** members can choose to have a standing order that is automatically placed for them by the website (one bag every week, for instance).
- 2. Detailed orders: members can personalise their bag of vegetables.

## Tasks to be considered in later phases (not estimated yet)

- 1. SMS notifications and opt-outs: a member can choose to receive pick-up reminders and other notifications by SMS. The website allows the user to select which messages they would like to receive (e.g. newsletter, pick-up reminders) and via which channels (e.g. SMS, email).
- 2. Local administration with stats and permissions control: local admins can look at the stats of their department (number of orders, number of members, etc.) and can edit the role of members (permissions).
- **3. Accounting admin system:** integrating the accounting with the system (kontantregnskab).
