Driver's Ed Classroom: (August 20 Update)

The Fall Driver's Ed classroom registration will open on September 9th at 10am.

How to register: All registration must be done and paid for **online** during the registration window.

Registration for Driver's Ed is available for all Cary High students that are above 14.5 years of age as of the first day of class. Paper forms will not be accepted. Registration is first come first served. No preference is given based on age. Seats fill quickly. There are no waiting lists.

Students can only attend driver's ed classes at their base school.

Fall Schedule Below:

- Session #1: September 29,30, October 1, 2, 6-9, 14, 15, 2025
- Session #2: November 12-14, 17-21, 24, 25, 2025
- Session #3: December 1-5, 8-12, 2025

When selecting a course, please take into account that the student <u>must</u> be able to attend the entirety of every class. If sports, appointments, or family trips overlap with the above dates, register for a different session. We will also offer 4 classes during Spring Semester.

Please note that Driver's Education is a two part course, classroom and behind-the-wheel driving instruction. Expect a <u>5</u> month waiting period between taking the class and getting behind-the-wheel. Please recognize that this is a long process.

Behind-the-Wheel (BTW): (August 20 update)

 Drivers are contacting the students who took the June class of 2025 currently. Instructors will call parents by

- phone to schedule driving. If you screen your calls, please realize that you might miss a call.
- BTW must be scheduled with the parent/guardian. Please speak to your driver via phone call; students cannot make arrangements themselves. Drivers meet students at CHS and must return students to CHS for parent pick-up.
- Each student has 6 hours of BTW time and 6 hours of observation since there are 2 students in the car.
- Once BTW concludes, the driver will issue a Certificate of Completion. Please review it carefully BEFORE you leave the lesson. If you lose it, refer to this link to request a \$25.00 replacement copy from JDS: Lost Driver Education Certificate
- DMV Eligibility Certificates (DECs) are issued through student services and can be picked up by the student or/parent. You will need to show your copy of the certificate of completion. You must have the DEC for your DMV visit.
- Students must remain in good academic standing; DMV will issue a revocation as outlined below from page 14 DMV handbook: DMV must revoke the driver license of any person under age 18 when it receives notice from the proper school authority that the person is no longer eligible for a Driving Eligibility Certificate. This revocation remains in effect until the person's 18th birthday unless a Driving Eligibility Certificate, high school diploma or GED Certificate is obtained.
- ***If your student has turned 18, s/he must have an adult learners' permit from DMV.
- Wear appropriate clothing and shoes for BTW no sandals, flip-flops, etc.
