# Safe Walking Routes Plan

- SCC chair sign plan
  - Church parking lot -
    - We were not able to staff the parking lot last year, but we were able to hire someone to staff the parking lot for safety.
    - Had city paint the curbs.
    - Most issues came from parents coming into the lot rather than leaving it.
    - At 3:35 aide stops cars from being allowed to enter that parking lot.
    - Add to skyalert, suggest to parents who are late and cannot enter to have a secondary location to meet in case they can't make it in before 3:35.
    - Add to skyalert, mention to not park on red painted sections of sidewalk when waiting for students after school.
  - o Sidewalk issues -
    - North side of 9800 South, the sidewalks are very icy.
    - Concrete lifting on sidewalks on West side of 2700 West (East of Sweet Blossom) on 9800 South. There was a flag placed there at one point, but it would be beneficial to have it repaired.
  - School Concerns -
    - Lots of parents wait at the East corner, by the church. Can we look at solutions to make that area larger? Possibly moving the fences back on to the blacktop to create more space.
  - Nothing has changed on our safe walking routes in a very long time.

### **Proposed 2023-24 Land Trust Plan**

- We have a math goal, Reading Goal, Arts Goal and Resource Goal
  - Other focuses, such as Science rely heavily on reading. Even with Science and RISE they are more reading based. You need to have reading skills in order to be able to do other focuses.

- Math & Reading (both similar goals)
  - Teachers meet daily in PLC's
    - Select and/or review essential standards for their grade level.
    - Select and/or give common formative assessments
    - Create intervention and enrichment groups on the data from district
  - Substitutes will be hired to cover classes for teachers to collaborate in extended PLC's
  - Assistants will be hired to provide small group or one on one instruction for students (RTI/Walk to Reading)

#### o Resource

- Goal: To have all students in resource show growth at described in their IEP goals
- Measurements:
- Can we make the position more valuable?
  - There are aids/classroom assistants and a special assists under this program. - usually the only difference would be pay. Trainings are similar.
  - Position needs to be consistent.
- Possibly put out a request for parents who might be interested in volunteering time.
- Hiring the "right" person is essential for this position.

#### Arts

- Autumn Montgomery is the music teacher this year.
- Goal Increase integration of the arts curriculum into the CORE Curriculum by at least 1 lesson per grade by May 2023
