


# **Improvement Team Activity**

At the spring site visit on April 6th five - seven students in our target population will participate in a focus group where we can better understand how they are experiencing the student goal setting change(s) in the 11th grade advisor block. We want to understand what is working and what is not working.  Action Plan:  By March 18th: Improvement Lead identities 5-7 students [name, name, name, name, name, and name] within the target population from the English 9 class, blocks 2 and 3  By March 25th: Improvement Lead works with SL and teacher to ensure students can be pulled into focus

	Current State: We have Change Ideas happening in Engilsh 9 and Math 10 classes. The teachers are aware of the changes and have been a part of early conversations on identifying the changes. However, they are not consistently a part of conversations regarding the work that they are closest to. They also have inconsistent interactions with PDSA cycles that reflect practices they prioritize in their classrooms.	Desired State: By July 2022, we will enroll Brittany, our English 9 general education teacher and Jose our Math 10 general education as testers by setting up meetings to conduct PDSA cycles based on the change ideas and instructional plans.  Action Plan:  By April 11th: IL sets up two 30-minute check-ins with Jose and Brittany to review what they are prioritizing for the next 6-8 weeks and connects those priorities to current change ideas. IL	



reviews the purpose and process for PDSA cycles and establishes a meeting structure for when and how they are able to meet to discuss the plan, study and act portions of the PDSA cycles for the next 6-8 weeks.  By [date]: IL invites Brittany and Jose to the improvement team meetings

Current State: Care takers are currently unaware of our improvement project and work with the network.	Desired State: At the May 16th Family night, SLs, ILs and PS will provide a 15 min overview of the improvement at both focal sites. This will include an easily interrupted version of the Aim statement, high level descriptions of the Primary Drivers, and Changes Ideas currently being tested and prioritized for the remainder of the year and possible changes for SY '22-'23. Families will be able to hear from key stakeholders, make connections to their students' experiences, and have an opportunity to ask questions and inquire about more information.  Action Plan:  By April 8th]: SLs from both focal sites sends IL and PS calendar invites for the May parent back to school nights.  By May 2nd: PS and IL create and send presentation slides of Aim, Primary Drivers, and Change Ideas in easily interrupted language that is visually organized and paints a clear picture.
