Lastly, send this book to school with your child, so they can share it with our Fireside community. We will invite kids to have their picture taken with their book to put up around the halls of Fireside.

- ☐ Introduce yourself, your student, and the book you will be sharing. Explain why this story represents your culture and/or why it is important to your family.
- \square Read the story, showing the pictures as clearly as possible.
