

## How to show rabbits:

- Rabbit showmanship is more of a health check
- The book has all of the different information on the breeds as well as showmanship knowledge
- There's a total of 100 points
- You start off by checking his/her spine
- And then move on to the ribs
- And then his/her belly to feel any lumps, bumps, or abnormalities
- Then you move on to the fur
- Check for density plus make sure it's not too long or too short.
- Then move on to color variety for their breed
- Also check to see if they have fur mites
- Common areas for fur mites are the ears and along the stomach
- Next check his/her ears
- Check for the correct tattoo on the left ear, making sure he/her doesn't have ear mites or rips/tears along the edges of the ears
- Then check the length of the ears
- The ears shouldn't go much past the nose
- Next check the tail
- Check to make sure it's straight and does not have a rye tail or broken tail
- Next check the eyes
- Make sure there is no discharge which could end up in sickness
- Check the nose
- They have 4 toes and a dewclaw
