## **Minutes**

We started the meeting by giving the council a rundown of what we have going on this week. We also got an update on issues that have been going on at Starbucks. Students have been involved in altercations, both verbal and physical. Dr. Michael plans on addressing this in the next newsletter.

We continued our discussion on the topic of starting an opportunity room. The initial amount was changed to accommodate an opportunity room for both lunches. We would compensate an individual or individuals \$2000 per semester, totalling \$8000 for the school year. Everyone agreed there would be benefit in implementing this change.

Next we discussed helping the IMS Choral Program in covering an unanticipated second charter bus, due to a large number of students attending the trip. Two questions from the group: Are

6th graders allowed on the trip? Why was this change made, since this trip was only for 7t and 8th graders in the past? We discussed what amount would be appropriate and what we would do in the future when other school groups needed financial assistance. It was suggested that we determine a set amount we would dedicate for groups (or even a percentage). It was ultimately decided we would dedicate \$2000 to cover the cost of the remaining \$4290 that Dr. Brauer needed. Dr. Michael also wants to use a recent donation for \$1000 to cover the remaining \$2290 for the charter bus.

On the good of the order, Ms. Flader asked about the fine arts and food trucks event. Dr. Michael will check with fine arts teachers.
