

## Director's Report

December 15, 2021

### Circulation

As you will see from the included Polaris report, our circulation for October was 532. Our circulation for November 2020 was 658. These figures do not include the honor books and jigsaw puzzles. I have also included two new reports. One shows the number of holds placed and filled – either through the online catalog, or by staff. The second shows our circulation broken out by zip codes.

### Library Wireless

In November our wireless network was accessed 76 times, with an average of 8 clients a day.

### Inter-Library Loan

In November, we received 115 books and other items to fill requests made by our patrons. We also sent 180 items to other libraries for their patrons.

### New Patrons

We registered 2 new patrons in October.

### Collection Development

In November, we added 29 adult books, 10 young adult books, 5 children's books, and 1 magazine. We discarded 49 adult books and 178 Children's books.

### Book Club

This month we read The Rosie Project by Graeme Simsion, and discussed it over Zoom on Tuesday, December 14. This Is How It Always Is by Laurie Frankel on November 16. In January, we will be reading Vanishing Half by Brit Bennett and meeting via Zoom January 18.
