Citation should have: author, book title, publication-place, publisher, year, page used

CENSUS:

Citation 1790-1840 should have: census year, county, state, township, page number, line number, head of household; website accessed info; NARA publication number, roll number.

PROBATE:

Citation should include: **locality**, **type or name of file & number**, **name of person deceased or minor**, **type of record and date**, **name and location of repository where filed**; website accessed information.

NATIONAL ARCHIVES:

Citation should have: **record item**, **file unit**, **series**, subgroup, **record group**, **repository**. Order-smallest to largest. Not all citations have all elements

INTERVIEW:

Citation should have: **name person interviewed**, **where living at time**/ **type interview**/ **name interviewer**/ **date interview**; **content stored or repository**; brief summation of topic

Paul Franklin Lindberg, Salt Lake City, Utah, interview by Karen Rasmussen (daughter), 13 November 1983; audio recording and transcript privately held by interviewer, Kingwood, Texas, 2023, childhood recollections.

PERSONAL INFORMATION: (only justified if you are citing information you witnessed or participated in)

Personal knowledge of the author, Karen Lindberg Rasmussen, Kingwood, Texas. Author, daughter of Paul Franklin Lindberg, was present at time of death on 17 March 2002.
