Dog Registration: Dogs must be registered with the North American Sport Dog Association. Registration is a one-time fee of \$25.00. You may register your dog online at <http://nasda.dog/registration/>

Run Order: Run order will be announced in final confirmation email and based off of known weather. Changes to run order may be made on the day of trial based on judge and club discretion.

Awards: Awards will be handed out at the conclusion of the trial. Ribbons are awarded for Qualifying scores and High in Trial. New title ribbons will be awarded.

Bitches In Season: Bitches in season are eligible to compete. They must notify the Trial Secretary via email in advance of the trial. Bitches in season will run at the end of the event and must wear appropriate britches.

Move Ups & Downs: In accordance with NASDA rules, move ups and downs are permitted for teams who complete a title at the event. All changes must be made before the class in which the team wishes to compete begins.

Venue: Exhibitors will be crating in their vehicles. Please pack food and water for you and your dog as there are limited food options near the venue.

Notice to Exhibitors:

- Entries may be paid via PayPal to: mamilligan07@gmail.com (must pay via "Friends & Family" or add \$5/trial) or check to Sniffington's (address located on top of entry form). Please include a note of "NASDA April Trial entry" and your dog's name).

Coming Soon

- Entries are limited to 8 hours of judging per day. If the trial fills, a wait list will be created, as needed
- Cancellations must be made via email to the Trial Secretary
- There are no resets for any class/level. Handlers with multiple dogs in the same class at these levels please take note.
- Entries canceled prior to the closing date will have their checks shredded; checks will be deposited on the closing date of the trial
- Refunds for entries paid via online payment and canceled prior to the closing date will be mailed 7 days after the trial.
- No refund for cancellations after the closing date.
- No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A declined payment or returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30 fee for any returned check or payment. Checks must be made payable to Sniffington's
- Sniffington's reserves the right to refuse any entry without cause or explanation.
- Sniffington's reserves the right to remove any individual for any reason from the premises.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any cause beyond the control of Sniffington's
- Absolutely No alcohol or drug use allowed during the trials. If suspected, you will be asked to leave immediately with no refund and your entries will not be accepted at any future Sniffington's event.
