- Measure and manufacture linen items, curtains and other furnishings,
 including calculation of fabric requirements and documentation of such
- Fit and issue uniforms for all grades of staff including the measurement and release from stock to hemming, marking and dispatching.
- Security transfer marking of all types of linen and protective clothing using a heat seal machine and computerised system.
- Print name tapes using a computerised system and heat seal onto all linen, clothing and uniforms.
- Accurately measure wards and departments for window and cubicle curtains Introduce new templates for the recording of requisitions, sizing of uniforms, unclaimed badges and unclaimed uniforms when required
