Grade: 2		Course: Visual Art		
Course Overview: Second grade art focuses further on good artist habits with more focus on the steps of the creative process in particular. Second grade art also includes a more general reference to current and historical artists and works of art. The art room is designed to operate as a working art studio. After learning basic skills and procedures (first quarter), students are then given the freedom to plan and design their own projects. Sometimes they are asked to work within a theme or with certain material limitations, but most projects are completely student driven with teacher support/coaching. This environment allows students to authentically practice the creative process while learning problem-solving skills, independent work habits, and respectful collaboration.

Each composition should have the same pieces as a story--characters, setting, details.
