1. School Data Share – Granite Park RISE scores, MGP and Proficiency. Discuss school Academic Goal from 2023-24, school plan.
  - a. Reviewed school goals:
    - i. Academic: Increase RISE scores by 5%
    - ii. Social Skills: increase self efficacy by 10%
    - iii. Talent development: 75% of staff feel training is meaningful
  - b. Reviewed RISE scores (comparison between 2023 and 2024)
  - c. Reviewed student growth data (MGP)
