We host conversations on feminist theory, history, and intersectional activism. We also learn together through workshops, shared interest and collaboration. We are a club affiliated with the Gender, Sexuality and Women's Studies department. However, this club is open to everyone at York!

This position will look wonderful on your resume! EFTY also provides lots of flexibility for chairs and executives. You can focus on your interests, and the position and club are really open to what you and the fellow chairs and community members are interested in.
