

Stages and Phrases

Stages are the steps you need to go through to “do” the can-do statement. For example, to meet someone, you have to provide your name and some information about yourself.

Phrases are specific parts of the text you could repurpose by taking out the information specific to this text and adding in the information relevant to your own. For example, “We will travel to the desert” can be changed to “We will travel to _____”. Then you can fill in your own information.

Stages:

Phrases:
