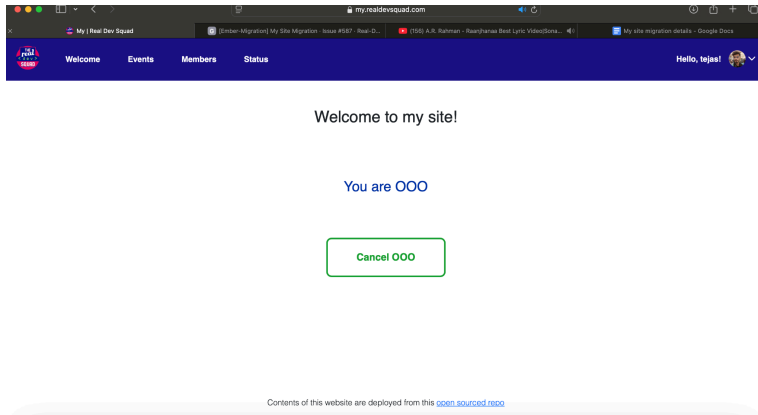

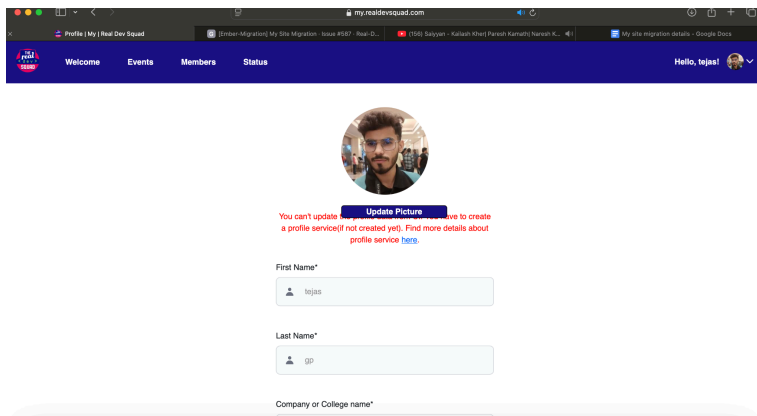
## Feature: User Status

- **Description:** Allows users to indicate their current status as active or set to Out-of-Office (OOO). This feature is essential for coordinating availability within the team.



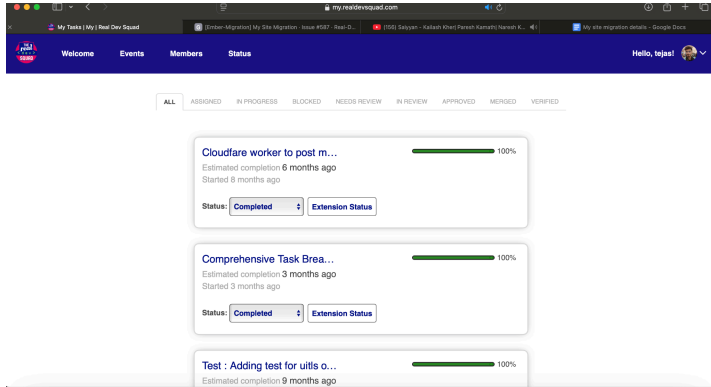
## Feature: Profile View

- **Description:** Displays the user's profile details. Users can view their profile and update their profile picture.



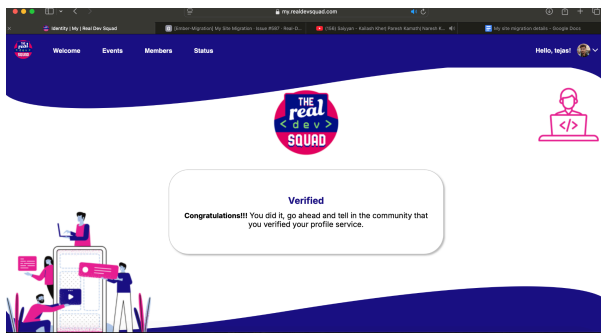
## Feature: Task Management

- **Description:** Provides users with a list of tasks they can manage. Users can update the status of tasks and request extensions if needed.



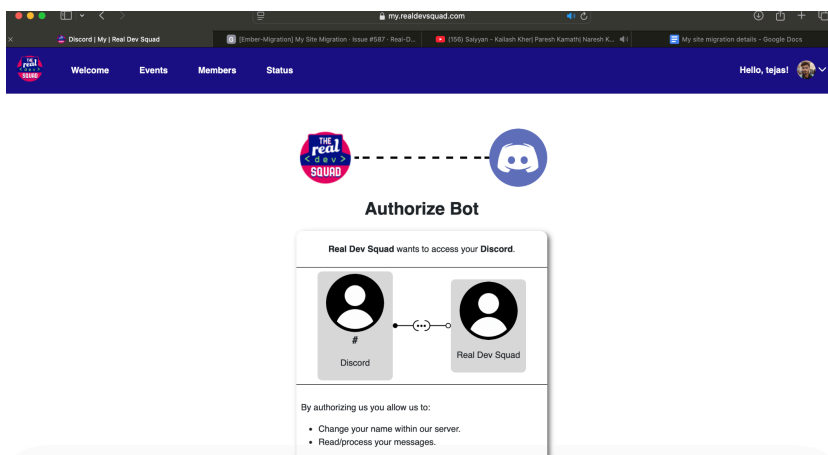
## Feature: Identity Linking

- **Description:** Allows users to link various profiles to the RDS account and view their identity status across connected services.



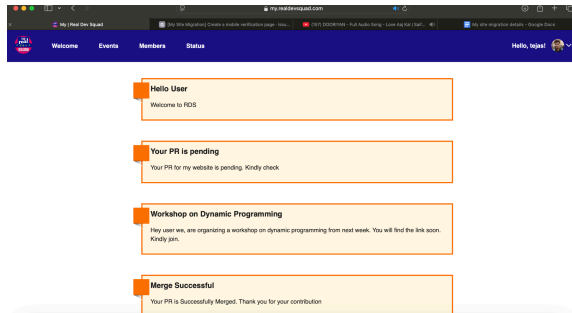
## Feature: Discord Verification

- **Description:** Connects the user's Discord account to the RDS backend, enabling them to verify their identity and integrate with RDS community channels.



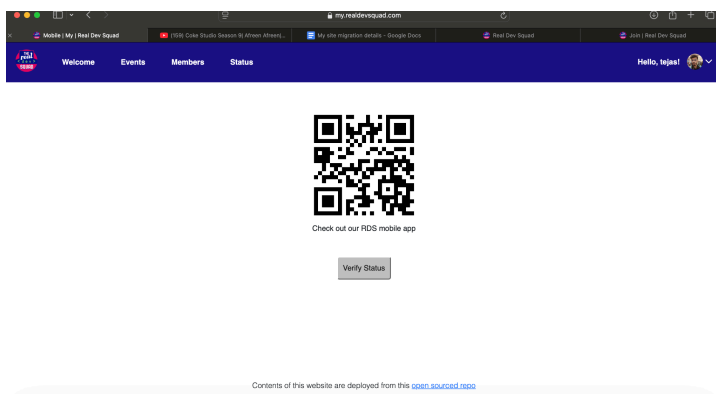
## Feature: Notifications

# My Site Migration: Testing Plan & Product Sign-Off

## Overview

This document outlines the testing and sign-off process for site migration. After thorough testing, the features will be handed over to the product team, specifically to Ankush Dharkar .

Below are the **instructions** that must be followed before submitting the testing document for product sign-off.

# Instructions to Test the Feature

Please read these steps as well as [Caveats & Special Considerations](#)

## Step 1: Create a GitHub Ticket

- We will open a new ticket in the [main-site-repo](#) on GitHub.
- Clearly document:
  - The feature's intended functionality is in the my-site.
  - Step-by-step instructions on how anyone can test the feature.

## Step 2: Record a Video Demo

- Then we will create a **1-2 minute video** explaining how to use the migrated feature.
- The video should demonstrate the feature in action for clarity. And add to the ticket created above.

## Step 3: Peer Verification

- We will share the GitHub ticket with **three developers**.
- Ask them to test the feature and **comment on the ticket**, confirming that everything works as expected.
- If any issues arise, they should document them in the ticket.
- Once three developers have verified the feature:
  - Share the ticket with **one of the Engineering Heads** for final verification.
  - Request them to **comment on the ticket** after reviewing it.

## Step 4: Resolve Issues (If Any)

- If issues are reported in **Step 3**, fix them and **repeat the verification process**.
- Once resolved and verified, please share the **GitHub ticket link** in the **group chat**, mentioning me.
- I will **attach the ticket link** to this document after completing step 6

## Step 5: Remove Feature Flags

- Once the above steps are complete, please **remove the feature flag from all migrated features**.

- Please notify me once this is done so that we can quickly shift our focus to step 6.
- 

## Step 6: Deprecation Notice

- After completing all the steps mentioned above, I will add a **deprecation message** on all relevant routes of the [my-site](#), attach the testing commands tickets in this doc, and we will sign off the migration to the product team. After showing this redirection message, we will redirect users to the main-site after n seconds, these n seconds will keep on decreasing after few weeks.

## Caveats & Special Considerations

### [/discord](#) Feature

- The [/discord](#) feature **cannot** follow the standard verification steps since it only works when a **new user joins our RDS server**. I'll take care of this as it was assigned to me.
- I will request that **Ankush** add my **secondary Discord account** to the **RDS server** to test this feature in production for a few minutes. Here is the [ticket link for the same](#)

### [/tasks](#) Page Migration

- The [/tasks](#) page is being migrated to the **status site**.
- This requires **extra attention** to ensure users are properly redirected.

### [/status](#) Page Migration

- The [/status](#) page in the main-site migrated from my-site has one special consideration when requesting OOO requests. When the dev feature flag is on, the OOO requests need to be first approved by superusers. Since the status page is also under the same feature flag, the current behaviour for OOO requests can't be tested.
- For testing [/status](#) and OOO requests, the feature flag will be removed and behaviour for OOO requests will be tested under both scenarios:- when the dev feature flag is on and off.

### [/notifications](#) page

- We don't have to remove the feature flag from the main site, and we don't even need this much of through testing. It will be overkill for that as that is a static site currently that is planned to build later.
