SMART SNACKS IN SCHOOL

- Be a “whole grain rich” grain product; or
- Have a fruit, vegetable, dairy product or protein as the first ingredient; or
- Be a combination food that contains at least 1/4 cup of fruit and/or vegetable; or

NUTRITION REQUIREMENTS

- Calorie Limits: Snack Items-less than 200 calories or less, Entrée Items 350 calories or less
- Sodium Limits: Snack Items 200 mg. or less Entrée Items 480 mg. or less
- Fat Limits: Total Fat no more than 35% of calories
- Saturated Fat: no more than 10% of calories, Zero Grams of Trans Fat
- Sugar Limits: No more than 35% of weight from total sugars in foods

BEVERAGE GUIDELINES

Schools are Allowed to Sell:

- Plain water, unflavored low-fat milk, flavored and & unflavored non-fat milk, and 100% fruit/vegetable juices with no added sweeteners.
- Elementary schools may sell 8oz or smaller sizes of milk and juice.
- Middle and Senior High schools may sell 12oz or less portions of milk & juice.
- Senior High schools can sell lower calorie beverages 12 oz or less portions and up to 20oz portion for calorie free beverages.
