



2026 Vendor Agreement

Welcome to the Dawson City Music Festival. Your application has been accepted! Below are the rules and regulations for vending at the festival. Please read thoroughly, sign, scan, and return. We hope you have a wonderful and successful time here.

1. LIABILITY & INSURANCE

While all precautions will be taken to guard against loss of inventory and equipment, the Dawson City Music Festival will not assume any responsibility for damage or loss of any kind. We encourage vendors to obtain their own liability insurance for this event.

2. CONTRACT, VENDOR FEE & DEPOSIT

All fees are listed on the application form. Vendor fee and vendor deposit are to be paid at the time of application. Full refund will be provided for any applications that are not approved.

Application deadline is: June 30, 2026

3. BOOTH OPERATION

Vendors may under no circumstance sublease their booth or any portion of their booth.

Booths must be staffed during all hours of operation.

No major changes to food menus will be permitted during the festival.

Movement of motorized vehicles is not permitted on the festival grounds during the festival weekend. We suggest that you provide your own wagon, dolly or receptacles for re-stocking booths, and refilling water.

4. REFUND POLICY AND DEPOSIT RETURN

Vendors who cancel more than 14 days before the event will be entitled to a 50% refund on all fees paid. There will be NO refund for cancellations made less than 14 days prior to the Festival. Deposit fees will be returned electronically by July 31, 2026. If a vendor leaves early, does not stay open during the hours that vendors are required to be open, does not abide by vendor rules, or leaves a mess, the deposit will be retained.

5. CAMPING

Vendors are NOT permitted to sleep on the festival grounds. Doing so will be in direct violation of our policy and will result in a request to leave and a loss of the damage deposit. DCMF offers overflow camping ([available for purchase here](#)); however, vendors are encouraged to find their own place to stay or camp for the weekend.

6. TABLE & CHAIR RENTALS

One folding table and two folding chairs will be available to each vendor. DCMF is not able to provide any additional infrastructure.

7. FOOD VENDORS

Food vendors must display their Temporary Food Permit at all times during the festival, and must comply with Yukon Territory's food safety regulations. Food vendors are allowed access to an electrical power source with a limited capacity. Vendors may bring their own power source to supplement. If bringing your own power source (i.e. generator), vendors should be cognisant of the noise level. We encourage covered boxes for generators.

8. ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

All vendors are encouraged to act in an environmentally responsible way. This includes minimizing waste, recycling material, and minimizing energy consumption. All recyclable materials and refuse must be placed in the bins provided.

9. VENDOR COMPLIANCE

Vendors must comply with the rules as stated. Failure to do so may lead to immediate expulsion at the discretion of the Dawson City Music Festival Board of Directors. It may also result in automatic refusal of space to vend in subsequent years and loss of the deposit.
