## 2. Golf N Golf Quick Verdict

Yes, without question — Gassan Khuntan was voted Thailand's best golf course in a 2015 poll of Chinese golfers, and it's easy to see why: 27 holes set against Doi Khuntan National Park, a historic century-old railway bridge and tunnel nearby, and a standout par-3 island-green hole. This is the natural finale to the Gassan Trail and one of the most scenic rounds in the Chiang Mai-Lamphun area.

## 4. Overview

Gassan Khuntan Golf & Resort opened in 2004 with an original 18 holes, and expanded to a full 27 holes in 2018 — making it the largest of the three Gassan Trail courses and the natural finishing point for a multi-day visit to the group. Set in Mae Tha District, Lamphun, near Doi Khuntan National Park, the course takes its name from the mountain that dominates the surrounding landscape.

The setting carries real history: the area is home to the historic Khuntan railway bridge and tunnel, a century-old piece of Thai railway engineering, adding a cultural landmark within reach of the course that few other golf destinations in the region can match. On the course itself, the standout is hole 5 — a 163-yard par-3 played to an island green, one of the most photographed holes among the Gassan properties.

The course's biggest credential arrived in 2015, when it was voted Thailand's best golf course in a poll of Chinese golfers — a meaningful distinction given how much of the

Gassan group's original marketing and guest base has been built around Chinese golf tourism. Combined with the scenic Doi Khuntan backdrop and the expanded 27-hole routing, Khuntan is a fitting, memorable finale after Legacy and Panorama.

## 5. Why Play This Course?

- Convenience: about 40–45 minutes from central Chiang Mai — worth the drive as the finale of a Gassan Trail visit.
- Reputation: voted Thailand's best golf course by Chinese golfers in 2015 — a genuine, documented accolade.
