As a Justice, she often helps other clanless down on their luck, only taking cases of richer folks when she truly believes in their innocence.

## Personality

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Kysal is a kindhearted, compassionate and sympathetic dragoness, one with a high set of morals she always follows, at the top of which her moral responsibility to help those in need. As such, Kysal became a Justice much like her mother, advertising herself as someone who stands by the poorer class, only taking cases of high class dragons when she believes in their innocence.

While not one to judge, Kysal tends to stay away from dragons she deems toxic, and is quick to determine who they are. She is very perceptive and doesn't discriminate against high class dragons when it comes to these matters, albeit the majority of toxic dragons (especially males) from her experience do end up from high class.

Although soft-spoken, Kysal knows how to bring a sharper edge to her tone, having mastered the ability over her years as a Justice. She is clever and is fully aware of her physical allure, using it as a bonus point to her charms when she needs to. All in all, she simply wants to help people and give back to her parents everything they have given her.

## History

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### ***Childhood***

Kysal was born to a middle class family of pure fire dragons, and ended up as a first generation blue fire dragon. While to most this screamed opportunity, her parents saw this as a concern due to the allure blue fire dragons presented. Both of them wanted only the best for their children, and have decided to have only one clutch. As such, they waited a rather long time to have it so they could save up coins first - specifically for temple education to give their child their best chance.

When it was finally time, their first egg unfortunately didn't reach its hatching time, having died beforehand. Heartbroken, the couple waited a few more years to try again. Thankfully, their second hatchling hatched a daughter; Kysal. Only after their celebrations did they finally come to the realization that Kysal scales were fully blue. The family never had a blue fire dragon before, and with how protective they now were, this caused some concern to the couple.

Regardless, they carried on, working hard for the sake of their daughter so she could have the best life they could offer.

Soon enough Kysal was placed in the Warfang Temple, a luxury not many were privileged to. She was excited and eager to meet new friends in her Flight, and she did. Most of her flightmates were kind and just as eager as she was. It was a rather mixed Flight, no clan dragons, but dragons of both high and middle classes. Even back then

Kysal knew the differences, as her parents made sure of it, scared she might accidentally offend the wrong dragon somehow.

The most notable member of their Flight was none other than [Novis](#). The young dragoness was rude, bitter and held the highest status within the Flight, belonging to a high and powerful family nicknamed “Cerulean Blaze” by most. Kysal attempted many times to befriend the hatchling, but with no success.

### ***Adolescence***

Through the years, Novis became more than just sour, she became dangerous. When fight practice finally started, Novis always won. She was Controlled before any in the Flight and was trained by her military family in every possible way.

The main issue was how rough Novis was, taking things too far too quickly, with their Flight Master in no rush to stop her. At some point, Kysal attempted to train her element further, to maybe help herself and her friends from Novis’ anger and strength. For a multitude of reasons, this never actually worked, and before Kysal knew it, she was leaving the temple with flying colors and taking her first steps to her new life.

This disheartened Kysal, who was now conflicted. As always, she brought this conflict to her parents. While both sympathized with her, they weren't sure what she could really do. Her father suggested she stay in the Guard, make changes through the system. Her mother had a different idea, one Kysal found very interesting.

Once she left the Guard, Kysal followed in her mother's footsteps and started to study under a senior Justice - a friend of the family - to better help the clanless who were “down on their luck”. It was only years later when Kysal was in her 30s that she started to take cases, all low profiles and “easy”. Squabbles or crimes between clanless dragons of the same status. She always picked the side she believed in, starting small to gain popularity and reputation.

When she felt confident enough, and had more resources and contacts, Kysal took a case against a dragon of high society. No, she *created one*. A case against the captain she served under so many years ago. After weeks of scouring for witnesses and victims, not to mention encouraging them to talk, Kysal finally built a case. With so much evidence there was no choice but to punish the captain. A fine and a dismissal from his service.

Kysal's reputation skyrocketed after that, gaining the popularity of many clanless, who could afford her far better than other “high and mighty” justices. While high society scoffed at her and viewed her as a scorn, over the years she also took cases for high class dragons, provided she believed in their innocence. While not every case was a win, Kysal was proud of the change she was making.

When Kysal was 53, working hard in the Warfang City Hall, her friends pulled her into a fun night out in the city. At the time, Kysal was working very hard and with little break due to work piling up, so a little night out was rather appealing for her (even if she had to say otherwise for appearances sake).

The group went into a club together and enjoyed their time. Kysal more than the others in truth, as she ended up flirting with a guy there. Intoxicated and charmed, the two ended up at the back rooms for the night, with Kysal slipping out in the morning before he woke up. She thought nothing of that night, it was just a nice little outing and nothing more, no attachments, no nothing.

A few weeks later however, Kysal realized that “no nothing” was turning into “yes everything”. She was pregnant.

Her parents were greatly disappointed, but supported her decision to keep the child and raise him as her own. She was at least old enough to have an egg with no issues, and she was financially stable. With the help of the Justice she studied under, a family friend, she was taught magic in her spare time, eventually attaining **Intermediate** mastery over her element.

Much like with Illyria, Kysal has a positive and close relationship with Girros. She didn't miss how having a son made Girros especially happy, finally a boy to play Boulder Toss with.

Per his request, Kysal named her son after her unborn brother whom her parents never got to actually name. Even if the name was quite a mouthful....

### ***Ignacarious***

Despite the way he was conceived, Kaysal absolutely adores her son and only yearns for his best. With the help of her parents she was able to secure Ignacarious the fundings for his temple education, so one day he could choose whichever path he would want to take in life.

Due to the “royal ring” of his name, Kysal often calls him *Little Smolder*.

She hopes one day he'll accept the truth that his father was simply a random dragon she met at a tavern, not some high and mighty general or the likes.
